Summary of post

The University of Exeter Medical School is excited to invite applications for two new Mireille Gillings Professorial Fellowships in Health Innovation with very competitive salaries plus unique programme grants of up to £1m. These appointments and the generous programme grants will enable the successful candidates to focus on developing new research programmes in their chosen field, with a particular emphasis on candidates who can promote the leadership of women in translational science and business, and are able to lead entrepreneurial activity in their area of research. We are seeking to recruit talented researchers who are looking to establish themselves as future leaders in their respective fields and establish a tenured career at Exeter. We are particularly interested in individuals who can deliver innovative health research in: Neuro imaging, PET imaging, drug discovery, Public health, Diabetes, Primary care, Dementia and Genomics.

Tailored and personalised support will be provided for leadership and entrepreneurial activities across area such as Executive Education, Coaching and/or MBA studies, depending on individual requirements, with the aim of creating health leaders who can navigate the complexity of partnering medicine and money and steer society through the health challenges of the future.

Main duties

Research

1. Lead the development of new and creative approaches in responding to health research challenges.
2. Lead research and other collaborative partnerships with other educational institutions or other bodies.
3. Lead bids for research, consultancy and other additional funds.
4. Write publications of the appropriate defined standard or disseminate research findings using media appropriate to the discipline.
5. Lead and develop internal and external networks to foster collaboration and share information and ideas and to promote the subject and the Institution.
6. Contribute to the enhancement of research quality and thinking in the field by being involved in quality assurance and other external decision making bodies.
7. Plan and implement research projects and monitor progress to ensure the achievement of financial and research objectives.
8. Support the development and implementation of the College research strategy.

Communication, Administration and Management

1. Be routinely involved in complex and important negotiations internally and with external bodies, particularly in relation to research, research funding and consultancy.
2. Participate in Institutional decision making and governance.
3. Participate in internal and external networks in relation to research and research funding.
4. Promote and market the work of the School in the subject area both nationally and internationally.
5. Exercise academic leadership for all subject area activities - teaching and/or research, as appropriate.
6. Act as line manager for matters relating to the employment of staff and ensuring the work is allocated fairly, according to skills and capacity.
7. Appraise and advise staff on personal and career development plans and mentor research activity within the discipline/College.
8. Develop and communicate a clear vision of the unit's strategic direction.
9. Promote a collegiate approach and develop team spirit and team coherence.
10. Foster inter-disciplinary team working.
11. Determine the allocation of resources within own area of responsibility.
12. Take overall responsibility for the organising and deployment of resources within own areas of responsibility.
